- (11:00 12:00) What Ministries Does God and our Neighbors Need from Sanctuary?

The Congregational Visioning Meeting will be called to order on September 19, at the start of worship. The meeting will be tabled at the close of worship that day. The Meeting will be reopened at the start of the retreat on October 1.


# Is this still who we are?

  - Improve Staff

- Built Capacity of and through Membership
  - Grow, Serve, and Engage Constituency
  - Leadership Development

- Right Size the Mission
  - Concern for Burnout
  - Scale Back reduce outreach efforts and social media footprint
  - Focus on ministries that the current membership wants and is willing to support
  - Don't do it unless you have volunteers to staff it
- Sustainability
  - Financial Stewardship Growth, More Reporting to Members, Ask for Donations everywhere and always
  - People define goals, track participation, develop follow-up by lay leaders; focus on spiritual health of the participants/members
