
All are a blessing to our journey of faith and we seek to share God's love and grace with all.

II. Doing Sanctuary: The Ministries

Using the Great Commandment and Great Commission categories we will Be Sanctuary in the following ways and distribute the expense of the ministries, staff and overhead accordingly.

- Love God (18%): Worship, Prayer
- Love Your Neighbor (30%): Care and Mission/Outreach Ministries, 10% Tithe, Special Gifts,
- Go Out and Make Disciples (23%): Casting the Vision, Building Partnerships, Recruiting Leaders, Evangelism,
 Inviting, Sharing, Advertising/Marketing, Social Networking
- "Baptize" Them (10%): Fellowship, Hospitality, Developing Community, Creating Communion, Community Organizing
- Teach Them the Things Jesus Taught Us (12%): All-Ages Faith Formation, Leadership Development
- Overhead Expenses (27% of the Budget) is distributed across the above categories of 'being & doing sanctuary'
 based on the percentage of ministry expenses dedicated to that ministry.
