  - a. 2022.10.06 BudgetvsActual Treasurer Report
    - November we address steward campaign
  - b. United Church Mission (50% of Mission Giving) not being distributed to MBA for three years of SNEUCC - need to reimburse and send separate checks going forward; proposal?
    - They will go back and fix this mistake 10% of the income of Sanctuary, 50% of that 10% goes to the United Church Mission to support the structure of the larger UCC. The other 50% gets divided up into our church mission
    - 8% of the total (what we gave the last year that they got money from us)
    - MBA is where we are and who helps us ... so this is like our tithing
    - What do we tell the congregation to send to MBA for the last 3 years
    - Joanna moves to ask SNEUCC to return 10% to MBA and moving forward we will designate 10% of that budget to MBA; Ray S. second. Unanimous.
