2:05PM: Discussion to extend 'lead pastor contract to June 30, 2026'

1. Terri Bracy raises question about the term 'interim' vs ' settled' pastor title, why do we not label Rev. Wendy as a settled pastor after ten years of service?

- Amendment offered by christy, seconded by Branwen This extension and its financial obligations are voided if and when Rev. Miller Olapade secures comparable employment elsewhere (Amend to add: except in the matter of a merger with Hillside) or would be terminated for due cause, i.e., inappropriate professional or personal conduct.
- Paul makes the point that adding this might create more challenges for the merger.
- We intend that this be valid no matter what happens in the merger with Hillside
- Christy withdraws Amendment, Branwen accepts.
- 2. Christy Miller votes to approve the contract, but does not require a second.
 - All members motion in favor, one abstention by Rev. Wendy
- 2:19pm: Moderator raises question about other potential new business
 - 1. Paul Roberts makes a point about the cost of records/documents keeping in a storage unit, ranging from \$1500 \$2000 annually
